


## QATAR SIEGE: IMPACT ON CONSUMER BEHAVIOUR

- PRICE CAPS SET BY GOVERNMENT DURING RAMADAN.
- PANIC ABOUT SHORTAGE
  AND LONG QUEUES AT
  STORES.
- RISE IN PRICES ADDITION-AL COSTS FOR TRANSPOR-TATION.
- AUGUST CPI FOOD PRICE IN-FLATION FELL TO 2.8% FROM 4.5% INJULY.
- CHANGE IN FOOD PREFERENCES (EG: ALMARAI HAD 90% SHARE IN THE DAIRY MARKET.)

#### **AVIATION SECTOR**

- · CANCELLATION OF VARIOUS FLIGHTS
- Hike in airfares to the southasian, European and north American continent for a few weeks.
- START OF SUMMER AND PRE- FLIGHT BOOKINGS.
- Reduction in baggage weight limit and increase in fuel burn which further increased the fare rates.




#### TELECOMMUNICATION SECTOR:

⇒ VOICE OVER INTERNET PROTOCOL (VOIP) CALLS
CANCELLED WITHOUT WARNING.

⇒ HAD TO SHIFT TO DIRECT CALLING SERVICES

ABROAD—RELATIVELY MORE EXPENSIVE.

#### TRADE BALANCE



- The imports of goods in July 2017 amounted to around QR 6.2 billion, showing decrease of 35.0% over July 2016.
- However, on a month on month (M-o-M) basis the imports increased by 6.3%.
- A massive decline in imports is seen due to the disruptions to trade because of the bloackade.
